- Terry has earned 13 (TD) Tracking Dog Titles along with 3 Tracking Dog Excellent Titles (TDX) 1 (VST) Title and has earned a Champion Tracking Title on her German Shepherd Renie. She also has multiple AKC & UKC Obedience titles.
- Terry continues working with her Tracking students and sharing their success through the years. Several of her students have expanded their knowledge & are involved in K-9 Search and Rescue and Pet Detective work.
- Terry has been involved in K9 Search & Rescue since 1995 and has assisted in over 150 searches. Terry's German Shepherds Anja and Nadie, and Tessa a Black Lab, now deceased, was certified in HRD (Human Remains Detection) on Land & Water. Nadie was certified in Wilderness & Urban Trailing, HRD (Human Remains Detection) Land /Water & Evidence Recovery. Tessa was certified in HRD (Human Remains Detection) Land / Water & Evidence Recovery.
- Terry is a Hug-A-Tree and Survive presenter. The Hug-A-Tree program teaches children how not to become lost... it also teaches children how to stay safe & survive in the wilderness until found.
- *May of 1998 Terry was awarded the Honor of Kentucky Colonel for her volunteer services with her K-9's in search and rescue.*
- *April of 2006 The Senate Of The Commonwealth of Kentucky recognized and honored Terry and her K-9 team in an effort to provide assistance in Underground Mine Emergencies.*
